# **Master Working Paper Series**

The MCEL Master Working Paper series seeks to give excellent Master students the opportunity to publish their final thesis and to make their work accessible to a wide audience.

### Conditions for publication

In order to give visibility to highly promising students interested in EU law and their research, outstanding Master theses in the field of European Law may be selected for publication on this page of the website of the Maastricht Centre for European Law subject to the conditions listed below.

## Eligibility

• The Master thesis must be written in the field of European law.

• The Master thesis must have received the grade of 9 out of 10 or higher.

• A master thesis graded with an 8.5 out of 10 may be eligible, subject to specific justification by the sponsor (see below).

### Submission procedure

• Submissions should be filed by a member of MCEL who has been involved in the grading process of the thesis ('sponsor').

• The sponsor must provide a short explanation on why the thesis is suitable for publication. This requirement is enhanced in the case of a thesis graded 8.5 out of 10 (eg. does the research deal with a particularly original research question?).

• Submissions should be sent to Prof. Bruno De Witte, one of the Directors of the Centre (bruno.dewitte@maastrichtuniversity.nl).

• We welcome submissions on a rolling basis.

### Selection procedure

- Only outstanding Master theses will be selected for publication.
- The final decision will be made by the MCEL Directors and associate Director.
