Such discussions can be invaluable inputs for the further development of presenters’ work, while offering them effective ways to enhance their knowledge on emerging research trends and network with other researchers in the UM community.

Submission Guidelines

Please submit an abstract of not more than 250 words electronically using the form: <https://goo.gl/forms/oKUF13Mhi1zYs3Iy1>. The abstract must include:

- Main objective of research (what is the research problem?)
- Significance of the problem (why is the problem worth solving?)
- Research plan/methodology (how is the problem addressed?)
- Innovation in the research (what is new - method, data, approach?)
- Anticipated results along with short- and long-term benefits

Eligibility and selection criteria

Submissions are open to all PhD students and postdocs at Maastricht University. *They must be enrolled at Maastricht University.* The submissions will be accepted on a ‘first come, first served’ basis until we have reached our full capacity. All accepted abstracts will be published online.
