Register in Studielink for the bachelor's in Medicine and indicate Maastricht as your first choice (compulsory). Consequently, candidates will receive their logon details for the 'My UM portal' via email. Follow the instructions in this email in a timely and accurate manner.

The first round of the selection procedure consists of a portfolio that must be completed online and uploading the addendum to the portfolio and the homework assignment in the 'My UM portal'. In addition, a limited number of candidates will need to apply for a "sufficiency check" **. If applicable, you must upload a syllabus per subject in the 'My UM portal'.

You will receive an email about whether or not you can move on to the second round.

For the second round you be present in Maastricht#. During the selection day, you need to complete a number of assignments that test various cognitive and non-cognitive features and skills.

Candidates who still have remaining subject deficiencies (= do not meet the requirements of all necessary subjects) on January 15, 2019 must upload a completed 'Definitive time plan', including supporting documentation, in the MyUM portal. In this document, candidates indicate how and when they will eliminate their deficiencies.

15 April 2019

Based on the candidates' performances during the selection day, a ranking is established. On April 15th you will receive your position in this ranking via email and Studielink will start issuing proofs of placement. If you receive a proof of placement, you **have to** accept this within 2 weeks in Studielink. If you do not do this in time, you will lose the place that was offered to you.

You must submit proof that you comply with the statutory pre-university, additional subject requirements by 16 July 2019, 16:00 CET. Proof of the language requirements must be submitted by 15 August 2019. If you are unable to meet any of the above mentioned requirements in time, you must apply for postponement of the delivery of the required evidence. The postponement request(s) must be uploaded in the 'My UM portal'.
