

# Addendum to the MSc Examination and Education Regulations (EER) 2026-2027

## Context of the addendum to Chapter XV of the SBE MSc-EER 2026-2027

This addendum pertains to a change in the curricula of the Dual Degrees with EDHEC Business School, NOVA de Lisboa SBE and LUISS. The articles for both incoming and outgoing students of the Dual Degrees with EDHEC Business School and Universidade Nova de Lisboa SBE are rewritten in this addendum in Articles 1 and 2, replacing the original articles. For the change for incoming students in the Dual Degree of LUISS, Article 3.1 replaces the original article and a slight adjustment is included in Article 3.2.

## Article 1 - Dual Degree with EDHEC Business School

### Article 1.0 - Applicability

1. Article 1.1 of this addendum applies to outgoing Dual Degree students with partner university EDHEC Business School, France, who begin their Dual Degree programme at SBE in February 2027.
2. Article 1.2 of this addendum applies to incoming Dual Degree students with partner university EDHEC Business School, France, who begin their Dual Degree programme at SBE in September 2026.
3. The Dual Degree programme with EDHEC Business School, France is offered in combination with all MSc IB specialisations.

### Article 1.1 – Outgoing students; Dual Degree with EDHEC Business School

This Article 1.1 replaces Article 15.7 section A in the MSc-EER 2026-2027.

#### A. **Master IB all specialisations – EDHEC Business School (École des Hautes Études Commerciales), France**

The Master's exam for the SBE – EDHEC Dual Degree programme consists of the following components:

1. The programme at the **SBE** comprises four (4) courses of 6.5 ECTS credits per course, one (1) compulsory skills training of 4.0 ECTS credits, and the Master's thesis of 17.0 ECTS credits. 47.0 ECTS credits in total will be listed on the final Master's transcript of SBE.
2. The programme at **EDHEC** comprises of compulsory courses, elective courses and an internship of 90.0 ECTS credits in total, of which a maximum of 13.0 ECTS credits will be considered to be curricular and of which 77.0 ECTS credits will be listed as extracurricular on the final Master's transcript.
3. The compulsory courses and thesis proposal skills training depend on the chosen specialisation, the list of electives is published on SBE Student Outline Study Programmes. Students can register for one of the following MSc IB specialisations and their corresponding MSc programme at EDHEC:

The programme at the **SBE** comprises five (5) compulsory courses of 6.5 ECTS credits per course, one (1) elective course of 6.5 ECTS credits, one (1) compulsory skills training of 4.0 ECTS credits, and the Master's thesis of 17.0 ECTS credits. 60.0 ECTS credits in total will be listed on the Master's transcript.

## Article 2 - Dual Degree with Universidade Nova de Lisboa SBE

### Article 2.0 - Applicability

1. Article 2.1 and Article 2.2 of this addendum are applicable to respectively outgoing and incoming Dual Degree students with partner University Universidade Nova de Lisboa SBE, Portugal who start the Dual Degree in September 2026.
2. The Dual Degree programme with Universidade Nova de Lisboa SBE, Portugal is offered in combination with the selected MSc IB specialisations as indicated in Article 2.1, paragraph 1 below.

### Article 2.1 - Outgoing students; Dual Degree with Universidade Nova de Lisboa

This Article 2.1 replaces Article 15.7 section C in the MSc-EER 2026-2027.

#### C. **Master International Business - Universidade Nova de Lisboa SBE, Portugal**

The Master's exam for the Nova Lisboa SBE – SBE Dual Degree programme consists of the following components:

1. The programme at the **SBE** comprises four (4) courses of 6.5 ECTS credits per course, one (1) compulsory skills training of 4.0 ECTS credits, and the Master's thesis of 17.0 ECTS credits. 47.0 ECTS credits in total will be listed on the final Master's transcript of SBE. The compulsory courses and thesis proposal skills training depend on the chosen specialisation, the list of electives is published on SBE Student Outline Study Programmes. Students can register for one of the following MSc IB specialisations:
  - Entrepreneurship and Business Development
  - Organisation: Management, Change and Consultancy
  - Strategic Corporate Finance
  - Strategic Marketing

1. The programme at the **SBE** comprises four (4) courses of 6.5 ECTS credits per course, one (1) compulsory skills training of 4.0 ECTS credits, and the Master's thesis of 17.0 ECTS credits. 47.0 ECTS credits in total will be listed on the final Master's transcript of SBE. The compulsory courses and thesis proposal skills training depend on the chosen specialisation, the list of electives is published on SBE Student Outline Study Programmes. Students can register for one of the following MSc IB specialisations:
  - Entrepreneurship and Business Development
  - Organisation: Management, Change and Consultancy

## Article 3 - Dual Degree with LUISS

### Article 3.0 - Applicability

1. Article 3.1 and Article 3.2 of this addendum are applicable to incoming Dual Degree students with partner University LUISS, Italy who start at SBE in September 2026 for the second year of the Dual Degree.
2. The Dual Degree programme with LUISS, Italy is offered in combination with MSc IB specialisation Strategic Corporate Finance or in combination with MSc IB specialisation Strategic Marketing.

### Article 3.1 – Incoming students; Dual Degree with LUISS in combination with MSc IB specialisation Strategic Corporate Finance

This Article 3.1 replaces Article 15.8 section E.1. in the MSc-EER 2026-2027.

#### E. 1. **Master IB specialisation Strategic Corporate Finance - LUISS - Libera Università Internazionale degli Studi Sociali - Italy**

The Master's exam for the LUISS – SBE Dual Degree programme consists of the following components.

1. The programme at the **SBE** comprises five (5) compulsory courses of 6.5 ECTS credits per course, one (1) elective of 6.5 ECTS credits, one (1) compulsory skills training of 4.0 ECTS credits, and the Master's thesis of 17.0 ECTS credits. 60.0 ECTS credits in total will be listed on the final Master's transcript.
2. The programme at **LUISS** comprises of compulsory courses of a total of 68.0 ECTS credits which will be listed as extracurricular on the final Master's transcript.
3. Graduation in: MSc International Business, specialisation Strategic Corporate Finance.

#### E. 2. **Master IB specialisation Strategic Marketing - LUISS - Libera Università Internazionale degli Studi Sociali - Italy**

Adjustment to paragraph 2: Instead of 72.0 ECTS credits, the programme at **LUISS** comprises of compulsory courses of a total of 70.0 ECTS credits which will be listed as extracurricular on the final Master's transcript.
