

MAASTRICHT Programme for Double Degree students from BOCCONI

Bocconi students in the Double Degree programme have to fulfill the requirements as applicable for the master's programme European Law School (ELS). The option to fill in 12 elective credits with an approved study abroad period is not open to the Double Degree students.

The Maastricht courses will have to contribute to the integrated Bocconi degree (Laurea Magistrale in Giurisprudenza) as well, so be sure that you have a valid learning agreement!

The 2020/21 ELS master's programme is included below.

You will have to enroll for each period separately. You are free to choose a specialisation, but you don't have to. Make sure that your course combination meets the requirements mentioned below.
