Marie-Sophie de Clippele obtained in 2019 a PhD on the burden of owners of protected cultural heritage in Belgian law and the question of a shared responsibility at the Université Saint-Louis - Bruxelles and the ENS Paris-Saclay. She currently holds a Postdoctoral Research Fellowship at the F.R.S.-FNRS (Oct 2019-Oct 2022), aiming to reveal the collective actors in cultural heritage law, by reflecting on the challenges and the modalities of its emergence and its inclusion. To empirically examine those theoretical questions she assesses the collective dimension of the repatriation of African heritage and the role of collective actors in the digitisation of cultural heritage.
