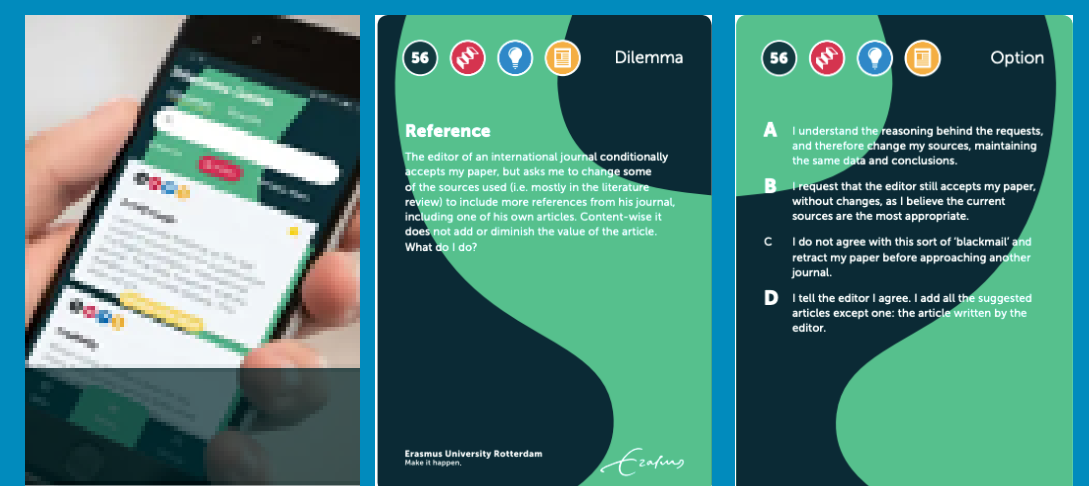


Scientific Integrity Aspects

Current Developments

- A workshop on research ethics and integrity for supervisors.
- A roadmap for PhDs, staff and students to make the contact points and routes in case of questions or complaints regarding scientific integrity to be more clear and transparent.
