Transcript of Records	An official Transcript of Records, including an explanation of the grading system, will be issued by the IRO within 5 weeks after the end date of your exchange. A digital copy will be send to the student. Upon request, the transcript can also be send to the home university.
Nomination Procedure	Your home university should send us an email to announce their acceptance of your choice to spend a semester abroad at UCV, including the following details: • Your First name, Surname • Your E-mail address • Your Nationality/Nationalities • Your current Study Level

Application Procedure	<ul> <li>After you have been nominated by your home institution, an application form will be send to you by email. Please return the completed form to us and add scanned copies of the following documents:</li> <li>A passport picture</li> <li>Copies of the ID page(s) of your passport</li> <li>Official academic grade transcript of current studies</li> <li>If applicable: copy of Bachelor diploma</li> </ul>
Visa and Residence Permit	For a temporary study period in the Netherlands, nationals from countries outside the European Union need an entry visa/residence permit. Please visit the Maastricht University <u>Visa Office</u> website for the most up-to-date information.
Insurance	Everyone (temporarily) living in the Netherlands is obliged to have a health insurance, including students. Liability insurance is also highly recommended. For more information please refer to <u>our website</u> . If you have an insurance but are not sure if it is valid in the Netherlands, please contact your insurance company. Some insurance companies (like <u>AON</u> ) offer special student packages, in case you do not have a health and liability insurance.
Housing	<ul> <li>We advise incoming students to start searching for suitable accommodation well in advance.</li> <li>The best way to experience the 'Venlo Student Life' is living in Venlo. Together with the <u>Students Information Point</u>, Maastricht University works at expanding the offer of student housing in Venlo.</li> <li><u>On campus Housing facilities</u> From September 2019 onwards, Campus Venlo offers 28 brand new on-campus student studios within walking distance to the market square, restaurants and cafes and opposite to the city cinema. All studios are furnished and have their own kitchen, bathroom, a combined living and bedroom.</li> </ul>
