

# PhD Positions Faculty of Law Maastricht University Faculty of Law Hasselt University Call for Proposals 2020

### Introduction

In 2020 the Maastricht University Faculty of Law and the Hasselt University Faculty of Law provide funding for two fulltime PhD positions. This call provides information on the application procedure.

# What can be applied for?

Two four year fulltime paid positions provided by The Special Research Fund UHasselt – Maastricht University in the framework of the joint PhD programme between Maastricht University and Hasselt University. One candidate will be appointed by Hasselt, one by Maastricht. Both will receive a double doctoral degree (2 separate degrees that refer to each other) between Hasselt University and Maastricht University. One PhD candidate will be appointed by Hasselt University will apply. One PhD candidate will be appointed by Maastricht University. The terms of employment of Maastricht University will apply.

# Who can apply?

- Graduates with a relevant Master degree and excellent grades. Motivated and determined researchers possessing first-rate analytical and writing skills. Final-year (master) students are (likewise) encouraged to apply if they have proven research skills.
- Candidates who have already started their PhD research, but are not employed as resident PhD researchers.

## When can applications be submitted?

The closing date for the submission is **Thursday 1 October 2020**, 23.59 hours.

# Preparing an application

An application consists of:

- a fully elaborated proposal drafted in English or Dutch (according to the language in which the dissertation will be written), using the application form attached to this call; academic transcript of bachelor's and master's degrees and list of grades;
- if the dissertation will be written in English, proof of the English language level (being a native speaker, having completed a university degree in the English language or having passed a IELTS or TOEFL test; a IELTS score of 6.5 with no less than 6.5 in writing or an internet-based TOEFL score of 90 with no less than 23 in writing is sufficient);
- the Master's thesis or, if applicable, another substantial piece of English or Dutch writing;
- short bio envisaged promotor(s) demonstrating expertise in the field of the proposal.



# Submitting an application

### **Assessment criteria**

# Scientific quality of the candidate:

- Study results
- Motivation and relevant competences

# Scientific quality of the proposal:

- scientific quality of the proposal
- quality of the research approach (methodology) and feasibility of the project
- quality of the research environment including excellence of lab (infrastructure, supervision, past experience, ...)

### Quality of collaboration:

- embedding of proposed project in research policy of the hosting research institute/group/school.
- explain how the project will enhance the collaboration between both universities
- indicate prospect of more sustainable collaboration
- equal involvement of both sides (UHasselt & UM)

The applications will be assessed by a selection committee appointed for that purpose by the Faculty Board of Maastricht University and the Research Council of Hasselt University. The preselection based will on the scoring grid. Candidates who make it through the pre-selection will be invited for an interview.

# Time schedule

1 October 2020, 23.59	Closing date submission of applications
End of October 2020	Applicants are informed whether they are invited for an interview
November 2020	Interviews
End of December 2020	Final decision by the Faculty Board of UM and approval by the Research Council at UHasselt for the Joint UH-UM applications
