


Policy for Human Development






- Approx. 110 instructors for 120 students

Application Procedure

- Deadlines EU/EEA: 15 July Others: 15 June
- Documents essay; letters of motivation and recommendation (x2); copies of diploma,* transcript,* and passport; TOEFL/IELTS/ Cambridge;† CV; passport photo
- Rolling admission Response 2-6 weeks after submission of complete application
- No numerus fixus or numerus clausus
