Descriptive summary of the project (main goal(s), main activities, main results) <p>Project to assist the Indonesian National Police through its training institution LEMDIKPOL in developing new courses for further training and re-training of police officers in service.</p> <p>To expand the current training capacity drastically the emphasis will be on the development of courses offered in blended learning formats (partly distance education/e-learning and partly contact hours).</p> <p>Various new courses in an e-learning format will be developed for selected police training centres ('pusdiks'), as well as 'Sepolwan', the women police school.</p> <p>Important themes in all trainings will be the bringing down of corruption, the protection of women and children's rights and the strengthening of the civil service side of the police.</p> <p>The projects relates to strengthening the rule of law and the legal sector in Indonesia, which is one of the priorities of the Dutch bilateral cooperation policy concerning Indonesia.</p> <p>The Institut Teknologi Bandung (ITB) is involved in the project for its expertise on developing e-learning in Indonesia, accommodated by its 'Com Labs' centre.</p> <p>Maastricht University Faculty of Law provides legal expertise in relation to police and criminal law, and on educational methodology and (legal) skills training.</p> <p>CINOP Global provides a local project coordinator and expertise on police training in the Netherlands.</p>
