<p>Descriptive summary of the project (main goal(s), main activities, main results)</p> <p>The main aim of this project is to strengthen the capacity of the International Law department at the Faculty of Law of Universitas Padjadjaran in Bandung, Indonesia. This strengthening includes the training of UNPAD IL staff with the overall aim to increase the quality of the education programs offered by the IL department, both in terms of contents and of the delivery/learning methodologies used. State-of-the-art knowledge for all staff on important themes in International Law will be improved with in various International Public Law topics, also in relation to ASEAN given the increasing significance of ASEAN for Indonesia.</p> <p>The project will provide support for the improvement of existing courses while also some new courses will be developed. The ambition is to introduce innovative and interactive teaching methodology. There will also be support for the educational organization (management and organization, assessment and examination, etc) next to the learning infrastructure (library, access to and usage of internet and other modern learning facilities.) All project activities will include attention for legal skills training, the learning and use of (legal) English and on gender mainstreaming.</p> <p>Furthermore the research capacity and output will be strengthened, and subsequent dissemination of research output will be increased.</p> <p>Another focal issue is improving of the department's extension capacity in relation to relevant national and international stakeholders.</p>
