Option 1 — Generative AI use not permitted

Generative AI tools (such as ChatGPT, Copilot, or similar systems) may not be used for this course or its assessments.

This restriction is necessary to protect the validity and fairness of the assessment and to ensure that the submitted work represents your own achievement.

Using generative AI for any part of your work will be considered unauthorised and may lead to an investigation under the academic integrity procedure.

Option 2 — Limited use of Generative AI permitted

Generative AI may be used only under the following conditions:

You disclose any use of AI in your submission, indicating which tools you used and how they supported your work.

The final product must still reflect your own understanding and achievement.
