Job Description

As a climbing instructor, safety is paramount, and it is essential that you act responsibly. You know how to convey your enthusiasm for the sport to UM SPORTS members. Additionally, you are driven to organize the climbing wall's occupancy optimally and motivate people. A friendly and approachable attitude is important. You will teach during regular class times and are able to deliver the full Indoor Toprope course, including conducting exams. You will also work with the student climbing association MaasSAC and contribute to internal and external events, such as team-building sessions and clinics for schools interested in the sport.

Responsibilities/Tasks

- Teaching climbing classes to UM SPORTS members.
- Providing the indoor toprope course.
- Conducting exams for the toprope course.
- Organizing clinics, team-building activities, and events for schools and companies.
- Collaborating with the team to keep the climbing wall appealing and accessible to members.

Requirements

We expect the following from our new climbing instructor:

- Extensive experience in sport climbing;
- Experience in teaching climbing;
- Possession of a SKI certificate (NKBV);
- Excellent communication and language skills in English and Dutch;
- Initiative, independence;
- Enthusiastic, customer-oriented, stress-resistant, flexible, and able to maintain oversight;
- Strong affinity with (student) sports, health, and exercise;
- Flexible availability throughout the week, with times negotiable both during the day and in the evenings, and occasionally on weekends.

The position is classified in scale 7 according to the UFO profile sports instructor, level 4, with a corresponding salary based on experience between €2,899 and €3,809 gross per month (based on a full-time position of 38 hours per week).
