Abstract

Participatory Design (PD) can help to produce sustainable and user-oriented outputs by involving end-users and other stakeholders in early design stages. As part of the cross-border collaborative project "Terra Mosana", several online PD workshops were held in 2020 in different cities of the Meuse-Rhine Euregion, to involve and engage residents in design activities about the investigation and communication of the shared history of the Euregion.

To mark the end of the Terra Mosana project, this workshop offers participants the opportunity to reflect on the process and products of the Terra Mosana project, and possibly give insightful ideas about how the network could be extended and developed into the future. After a brief presentation about the achievements of the project, the workshop will include several co-creation activities that will be conducted in sub-groups, such as *card sorting* in order to assess the achievements of the project and to discover what provokes participants in terms of the shared history themes and the interactive experiences. Activities also include *storyboarding* that will involve a development of a persona as a representation of the target audience, and a visualization of a scenario by drawing a sequential narrative of the experience.
