

Addendum to Chapter XIV SBE Master’s study programmes, article 14.14 in the SBE MSc EER 2022-2023

This addendum is a one-time change to the curriculum of the Master’s study programme Sustainability Science, Policy and Society (SSPS).

Article 1 Applicability

This addendum is applicable to all students who start their Master’s study programme Sustainability Science, Policy and Society (SSPS) in September 2022. This adjustment to the Master’s study programme SSPS is only applicable to academic year 2022-2023. Students who started their Master’s study programme SSPS prior to September 2022 cannot make use of the adjustments in the programme.

Article 2 Master’s exam of the Master of Science in Sustainability Science, Policy and Society (SSPS)

1. In deviation of paragraph 2 of Article 14.14, the course Sustainability, Law and the Environment (SSP2052) in block period 4 is not compulsory, but offered as one of two elective courses in the Master’s exam.
2. In order to meet the exam requirement within the available space for an elective course as stated in paragraph 1 of this Article, students need to choose one (1) elective course from the elective courses offered in period 4.
