# Important deadlines for application

#### Applicable when starting on 1 September 2022

When you want to apply or are applying for this study programme, it is important that you inform yourself of the deadlines that you need to meet. The important deadlines when applying for this study programme are provided in the table below.

Note: if you are viewing this webpage on your phone, we recommend that you use portrait mode.

1 October 2021	Studielink is open for applications for the academic year 2022-2023
Up to and including 1 May 2022, 23:59 CET	Deadline for completing the entire application process for <b>non-EU/EEA applicants</b> (these applicants require a <u>visa or residence permit</u> )
Up to and including 1 June 2022, 23:59 CET	Deadline for completing the entire application process for <b>EU/EEA applicants</b>

### How do we assess your application?

When you want to apply or are applying to this study programme, it is useful to know how we assess your application. You can find more information about this here.

The Board of Admission evaluates the quality of your application by looking at your Proof of Academic Capabilities (if applicable), IELTS/TOEFL score (if applicable), Grade Point Average, the level of statistics and mathematics and at how well your bachelor's programme corresponds with the master's programme. Besides this, the Board looks at your motivation, relevant work experience, international experience and extra-curricular activities. Based on this information, the Board of Admission will decide whether you can be admitted to the programme or not.

Assessment happens on a rolling basis. This means that, once you submit a complete file with all the minimum required scores, it will be presented to the Board of Admission. We will not wait until the deadline before we present your file to the Board. You will receive a decision within 2-4 weeks after completion of your file.

### **UM School of Business and Economics**

Are you student at Maastricht University (UM) and do you have one of the following degrees/certificates? In that case, you are directly admissible:

- a UM bachelor's degree in International Business
- a UM bachelor's degree in Economics and Business Economics
- a UM bachelor's degree in Econometrics and Operations Research
- a UM bachelor's degree in Fiscal Economics
- a UM pre-master's certificate in Learning and Development in Organisations
- a UM pre-master's certificate in Digital Business Economics
- a UM pre-master's certificate in International Business (all specialisations)
- a UM pre-master's certificate in Global Supply Chain Management and Change
- a UM pre-master's certificate in Business Intelligence and Smart Services

Except for a copy of your valid passport, you do not need to upload any other documents via <u>MyUM.</u>

If you have another bachelor's degree from a Dutch university, you are eligible for admission. Please upload the following documents via <u>MyUM</u>:

- List of grades of your bachelor's programme Upload a transcript of grades from each university you have attended, plus a translation if the original is not in English.
- Curriculum vitae
   List your education, relevant extracurricular activities, internships and (professional)
   experience.
- Letter of motivation
   Provide good arguments for why you want to do this master's programme at Maastricht
   University and why you expect that you can successfully complete the programme. This letter
   should be about 1 or 2 pages long.
- Form proof of academic capabilities
   To prove your analytical and mathematical skills you should fill out the standard
   template Proof of Academic Capabilities, insert your proof into the file and upload it via

- A recent passport picture
- A copy of your valid passport or your EU/EEA identity card

# Zuyd Hogeschool or Breda University of Applied Sciences

If you have successfully finished the Academic Minor (Zuyd Hogeschool) or SBM-programme (Breda University of Applied Sciences), you are directly admissible. Please upload the following documents via MyUM:

- List of grades of your bachelor's programme including GPA Upload a transcript of grades including a GPA from each university you have attended, plus a translation if the original is not in English.
- A positive recommendation from Zuyd Hogeschool
- A statement from your school indicating that you have completed the required programme successfully
- A recent passport picture
- A copy of your valid passport or your EU/EEA identity card

### **Relevant Dutch pre-master's programme**

Are you following or did you finish a relevant pre-master's programme at one of these Dutch universities? Make sure to highlight this in your application, since this will give you direct access to one of our master's programmes.

Please upload the following documents via MyUM:

- List of grades of your pre-master's and bachelor's programme
- Certificate of enrolment for the pre-master's programme
- A statement from the university of your pre-master indicating that you have finished the pre-master's programme successfully. Please use our standard template.
- A recent passport picture
- A copy of your valid passport or your EU/EEA identity card

# Other Dutch HBO programme

If you have a Dutch bachelor's degree from a university of applied sciences (HBO), you are eligible for admission. Even though a pre-master programme or Academic Minor/SBM-programme is strongly recommended, it is possible to apply without it. Upload the following documents via MyUM:

- List of grades of your bachelor's programme including GPA Upload a transcript of grades including a GPA from each university you have attended, plus a translation if the original is not in English.
- Curriculum vitae

List your education, relevant extracurricular activities, internships and (professional) experience.

Letter of motivation

Provide good arguments for why you want to do this master's programme at Maastricht University and why you expect that you can successfully complete the programme. This letter should be about 1 or 2 pages long.

 Form proof of academic capabilities To prove your analytical and mathematical skills you should fill out the standard template <u>Proof of Academic Capabilities</u>, insert your proof into the file and upload it via <u>MyUM</u>:

# Applicants with an international bachelor's degree

If you have an international bachelor's degree for a university or university of applied sciences, you are eligible for admission. Please upload the following documents via <u>MyUM</u>:

- List of grades of your bachelor's programme Upload a transcript of grades from each university you have attended, plus a translation if the original is not in English.
- **Curriculum vitae** List your education, relevant extracurricular activities, internships and (professional) experience.
- Letter of motivation

Provide good arguments for why you want to do this master's programme at Maastricht University and why you expect that you can successfully complete the programme. This letter should be about 1 or 2 pages long.

- **Proof of academic capabilities** To prove your analytical and mathematical skills you should fill out the standard template <u>Proof of Academic Capabilities</u>, insert your proof into the file and upload it via MyUM.
- A recent passport picture
- A copy of your valid passport or your EU/EEA identity card

In addition, Non-EU/-EEA students have to:

- Pay the €100 handling fee
- Proof of <u>English proficiency</u>
