Planning for impact

Where to find information on your topic's impact?

- your own experiences
- your network
- documentaries, podcasts, blogs, books...
- business review journals/company reports
- other researchers/studies

What can you discover in these sources?





Planning for impact

How do you ensure your results are valuable?

- theory: embed/define in existing research
- validity: capture what you intend to capture
- reliability: measure consistently
- ethics: consider your stakeholders
- security: protect your data





Planning for impact

Communicating impact in your introduction

What is the main problem, who cares, what is your goal - examples

What we already know – starting point in theory & practice

What is currently missing and why does it matter

How do you address this problem and why, RQ

Create impact as you go

Tips & tricks for ongoing focus on impact

- link you findings to your own experiences
- discuss your findings' relevance for your stakeholders
- share your (tentative) results with your network
- invite discussions on your results

What are other ideas for focusing on impact?





Create impact as you go

Questions to ask when framing your results

- which elements of my findings can be acted on?
- who can affect these elements?
- what should they do specifically?
- what are likely barriers to their actions?
- what are limitations of your approach?
- what can you not speak to based on your thesis?



Create impact as you go

Communicating impact in your discussion section

Why/to whom does your RQ matter?

How do your findings contribute to existing research?

What are limitations , what have you learned, next questions?

Which findings can be acted on, by whom, and what should they do?

Impact through interaction

How can you share your thesis findings?

One-sides sharing

Executive summaries, video summary, infographics, (social) media posts, podcasts, publishing an article...

Co-creating together

Informal chats, brainstorming sessions, discussions, networking, entrepreneurship, presentations...



Impact through interaction

My experiences

Impact as we go along

- Developing questions and approaches together
- Reflecting together over time

Sharing research findings with stakeholders

- do not judge, connect to interests
- share your findings factually and with empathy
- listen and be curious
