

Addendum to Section 3 Content and Structure of the programme, article 3.6 in the BSc Business Engineering EER 2022-2023

Article 1 Applicability

This addendum is applicable to all students registered for the bachelor's study programme Business Engineering in 2022-2023 and is only applicable to academic year 2022-2023.

Article 2 Deviating rules for students who went on a study abroad

1. In deviation of article 3.6, the skills training BENS2003 and/or the project BENP2003 in year 3 are not compulsory in case students did a study abroad.
2. Students who did a study abroad can take up to 30 ECTS credits at a foreign partner university. In case less than 30 ECTS credits are obtained, the student has to add courses from the electives of the BSc Business Engineering programme. The skills training BENS2003 or the project BENP2003 of year 3 can also be used to obtain additional credits. It cannot be guaranteed that no courses overlap; it remains the responsibility of the student to check if all course requirements are met.
3. Students can go on a study abroad in the first semester or in the second semester in or after their third year of the bachelor's study programme Business Engineering. Students who go on an exchange in the second semester in the third year in the first or second semester after the third year can only graduate with study delay.

Article 3 Deviating rules for students who start the Thesis Research Project (BENP2004)

1. Students can start the Thesis Research Project (BENP2004) in period 1, 2, 4 and 5 of their third year; and after they obtained 120 ECTS credits.

Article 4 Deviating rules for students with a study delay

1. Students with a study delay due to a skills training can retake the skills in the next academic year together with two courses and a new skill. For these students, it is allowed to take up to 15 ECTS credits in a period (a skills training of 5 ECTS credits is floating over 2 periods; so 2.5 ECTS credits workload in a single period).
2. a. Students with study delay in period 4 of the third year of the programme may decide not to start their Thesis Research Project (BENP2004) in period 4 but take a third course in case no skills training is followed. The approval of the third course is based on availability. It cannot be guaranteed that no courses overlap; it remains the responsibility of the student to check if all course requirements are met.
b. Students with a study delay in period 5 of the third year of the programme may decide not to start their Thesis Research Project (BENP2004) in period 5 but to take a third course in case no skills training is followed.
