

University Council: what exactly were we up to in 2023-24?

The University Council works closely with the Executive Board on all university affairs. Consisting of students, academic staff, and support staff, we regularly discuss new policies and current developments relating to strategy, research & education, and operations. We have briefly summarised last year's main efforts for you.

Diversity and inclusivity

- Advocated for the interests of students with (invisible) disabilities, chronic conditions or neurodivergence, through a working group that met with a number of stakeholders and made proposals
- Discussed the report of the social safety team for staff and students
- Advocated for improved accessibility of UM buildings
- Submitted a proposal to revise the language policy to prevent the exclusion of non-Dutch speakers

Research

- Discussed and questioned the review framework
 International Cooperation and Knowledge Security
- Was informed about the distribution of Starters and Incentive Grants
- Approved the plan to realise the Brightlands Circular Space Facilities





Education

- Monitored the implementation of Quality Agreements and NPO funding
- Approved funding for UM Digital Labs



UM and the world

- Played a large role in the establishment of UM's Global Engagement policy and its ties with institutes in conflict zones
- Provided input on the realisation of the Human Rights Due Diligence tool



Student housing

 Contributed ideas on student housing with an eye on the growing student population



Future of UM

- Participated in the selection committee of the new Vice-President of the Executive Board
- Exchanged insights with the Executive Board on the integration between UM and azM/MUMC+ and set out points of attention going forward
- Closely followed developments in internationalisation and discussed the consequences for UM with the Executive Board
